The SafeMa Course

A midwifery professional training course, which will be addressed to midwifery, nursing and medical graduates or in-service midwives who wish to develop their skills further. The SafeMA Course aims to become a leading midwifery programme in South East Asia and respond to existing skills shortages, while promoting clinical and research skills and experiential, hands-on learning.



About the Project

SafeMa project is a three-year initiative which aims to develop a midwifery professional training course on “Advances Midwifery Practice” in order to address the local needs in Vietnam and Cambodia.

Objectives

- ▶ Transfer best international practices to address local needs
- ▶ Promote clinical skills and research potential
- ▶ Awareness-raising, network-building & fundraising



Target Audience

The project targets international, national, regional and community actors involved in midwifery services, policy-makers, academics, researchers, health workers, students and general public in order to create strong local synergies.

5 SafeMa Hubs

One SafeMa Hub will be established in each Partner University. SafeMa Hubs will be teaching, research and pedagogic resource centers in midwifery. They will be centers for knowledge development, sharing and transfer concerning midwifery with a focus on evidence-based practice and research and on continuously advancing the clinical skills necessary for quality midwifery education and service in Vietnam and Cambodia.

SafeMa Virtual Learning Environment (VLE)

The SafeMa VLE will provide Massive Online Open Courses on midwifery, which will allow the collaborative interaction between their users through both learning and assessment activities. The VLE will support the SafeMa Hubs.

SafeMa Network of Excellence

The SafeMa network of excellence will be established with the support of SafeMa Hubs and will be based on face-to-face contacts, SafeMa dissemination activities and a forum that will be accessible through both the SafeMa VLE and Website. The network is expected to contribute to the project dissemination and fundraising activities.

Project Partners

Co-funded by the Erasmus+ program and coordinated by the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (Athens, Greece) the project will run in Greece, Denmark, Vietnam and Cambodia. Partners include University College of Northern Denmark (UCN) from Denmark, Readlab P.C from Greece, Thai Nguyen University (TNU), Hanoi Medical University (HMU) and Nam Dihn University of Nursing (NDUN) from Vietnam and University of Health Sciences (UHS) & International University (IU) from Cambodia.
